GIFT OPPORTUNITIES

The UCLA Faculty Club has a number of attractive gift opportunities described below.

MAIN DINING ROOM (EAST) - \$1,000,000

The Main Dining Room is the primary dining space and the largest event venue in the Faculty Club. With floor-to-ceiling windows, it looks out onto the Garden Patio. It is ideal for large dinners and receptions, weddings, concerts, life celebrations, banquets, and conferences. The addition of new double-glazed pivot doors or sliding doors would allow for seamless integration between inside and outside. Replacement of well-worn tables and chairs would further beautify this space.



MAIN DINING ROOM (WEST) - \$500,000

A compelling design opportunity exists to create a lounge area at the west of the main dining room. New furnishings -- including couches, chairs, tables, and lighting -- would give this space a living-room type of feeling where guests can relax prior to meeting their friends, colleagues, and guests.

GARDEN PATIO - \$1,000,000

This striking urban garden flows from and is adjacent to the Main Dining Room. It is a preferred outdoor dining space for members and has been the site of countless weddings, conferences, receptions, buffets, summer barbecues, and cocktail parties.



WEST PATIO - \$500,000

Conveniently located next to the Served, this charming patio will be enhanced by means of new landscaping, hardscaping, windows, and doors.

PLAYA CAFÉ - \$800,000

The Playa Café is the Club's much-loved coffee bar. In addition to all types of specialty drinks, the Café offers grab-and-go food items. Beach-themed photographs line the space reinforcing the room's playa theme. The Café's floor-to-ceiling windows link it to the Club's lively dining patio. A relaxed and informal atmosphere makes this spot a campus favorite.

CORAL GRILL - \$750,000

The Coral Grill offers restaurant-style fine dining at the Faculty Club, with wait service and a full range of made-to-order menu items. An outdoor venue, the Coral Grill is often preferred for special business breakfasts and lunches.

SEQUOIA ROOM - \$500,000

The Sequoia Room is a perfect space for large meetings or smaller, more intimate gatherings and can be partitioned into three rooms, each with its own separate entrance. It features high ceilings, recessed lighting, and natural light from the glass walls on the south wall. The room will seamlessly open out onto the renovated outdoor patio and accentuate the indoor-outdoor, mid-century-modern aesthetic.

HACIENDA ROOM - \$450,000

SIERRA ROOM AND REDWOOD ROOM - \$350,000

These rooms are attractive venues for smaller meetings, including conferences, poster sessions, lunches, smaller celebrations, and receptions. Enhancements include state-of-the-art audio-visual and lighting systems, new carpeting and furniture, and smart tables for conferences.



THE KITCHEN - \$500,000

With the goal of achieving Green Kitchen Certification, the Club seeks to sustainably manage its use of energy, water, and waste. An upgrade of its kitchen appliances will minimize environmental impact and lower energy costs. In addition, a replacement of dishes, flat-ware, and glasses will enhance guest experience.

THE LIBRARY - \$400,000

A long-favored place for quiet contemplation, reading, card playing, and solitary work. This room features the Toshi Ashikaga Book Exchange. A rejuvenation will include new furnishings, carpeting, and workstations.

PINES PATIO - \$300,000

This patio, passed en route to the south end of the Club, refreshes the eye with its gentle mounds of low-lying greenery that soften the verticality of the patio's four magnificent pine trees.

NAMED SPACES

SHERIE AND DONALD MORRISON ROOM & PATIO

Formerly the California Room and California Patio, these two spaces are the Club's most popular for events. The Morrison Room is the largest private room in the Faculty Club, serving as the primary site for academic conferences, concerts, banquets, organizational retreats, and more. The adjacent Morrison Patio provides a lovely and seamless extension of the Morrison Room, ideal for all manner of receptions and the favored venue for wedding ceremonies.

THE SHERIE BAR & LOUNGE

Formerly the Cypress Bar and Lounge, the Sherie Bar and Lounge was renamed in 2022 in honor of Sherie Morrison, Distinguished Professor of Microbiology, Immunology, and Molecular Genetics. The only bar on the main campus, the space contains a vintage wall-length series of carved-wood panels by California artist and designer Evelyn Ackerman.

MILLER-MORAN PATIO

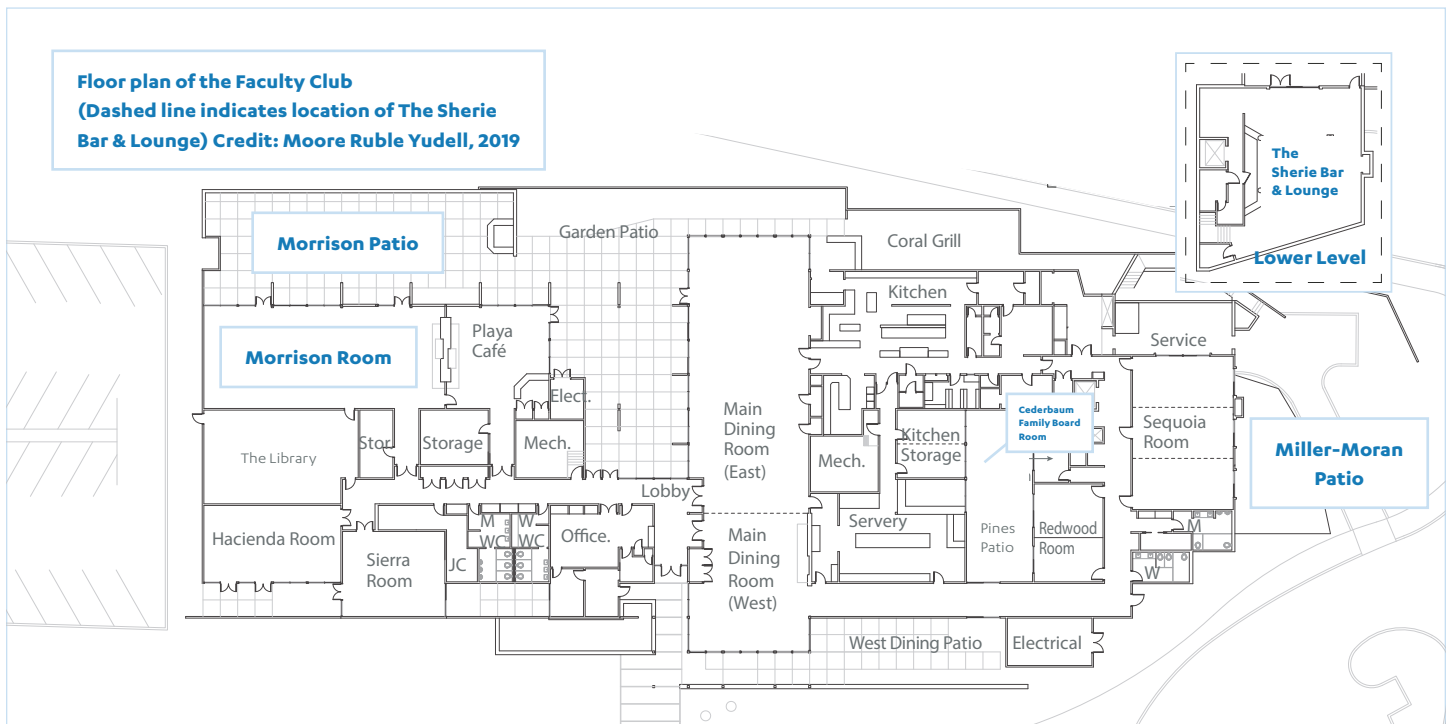
Formerly the Sequoia Patio, the Bruce Miller and Jennifer Moran Patio is ideal for interpersonal exchanges over coffee and drinks. Its curvaceous lines and attractive landscaping make it a gracious spot for entertaining.

CEDERBAUM FAMILY BOARD ROOM

This small private room, appropriate for executive meetings and small lunches, features a large flat-screen monitor.

VICTORIA STEELE GALLERY

The Victoria Steele Gallery in the north hallway serves as a gallery space that focuses on mid-century modern architecture.
